

#### What is important around the time of birth? Information for (expectant) parents in Treptow- Köpenick

The (imminent) birth of your child brings a lot of exciting changes in your everyday life. If you are going to be a mother or father soon, then you probably have to prepare a few things: find a midwife, take a prenatal course, have paternity certified and apply for parental leave.

**Attention:** The availability of the authorities and institutions changes frequently during the Corona Pandemic. Please inform yourself on the respective websites!

You will also find out what financial and material help you can apply for when and where and what documents you need for this.

Registration at the registry office	If your child is born in a hospital, the birth notification will automatically be sent to the registry office in whose district it is located.  The birth certificate must be signed by the parent(s) who have custody. If you give birth in a birth center or at home, the registration must be reported within a week by a parent with custody or a person who was present at the birth.  If you have already submitted the documents to the birth center and signed the determination of the name, you do not have to go to the registry office. The certificates will be sent to you by post against invoice.  If at least one parent is a foreign national, the foreign law must also be observed. The office hours on Monday can be used for a joint consultation. If necessary, an interpreter should be brought along.  You will receive three birth certificates free of charge to apply for government benefits.  Additional certificates must be purchased. Apply for child benefit	All children are entitled to child benefit from birth at least until they reach the age of 18.
