What is the holiday school?

The holiday school will help you in the core subjects (German, mathematics, English) as well as in planning for your professional future. In the holiday school you can voluntarily and at no charge

- Improve your school performance and your language skills,
- Increase your opportunities for starting a career and
- Prepare intensively for your educational qualification.

Who can participate in the holiday school?

Pupils of the welcoming classes and integrated professional training preparation (IBA) can participate in the holiday school. Pupils and trainees of the following educational programmes of vocational schools/Colleges of Further Education (OSZ) are very welcome:

- Vocational schools (BS),
- technical schools (BFS),
- technical colleges (FS),
- Technical secondary school (FOS),
- higher vocational school (BOS),
- vocational Gymnasium (bGym).

When and where do the holiday schools take place?

The holiday school takes place at various locations in Berlin during the school holidays. Coordinators of the holiday schools will connect the participants with the appropriate offerings. Before the start of the holiday school, participants will receive a personal invitation by e-mail with all the necessary information.

How can you register for the holiday school?

Registration can be made by

- Class teachers or educational counsellors,
- A social agency, company or
- With the coordinators of the holiday schools directly.
